OF DECISION 84-02-065

Applications for rehearing of D.84-02-065 have been filed by Kathy Wyrick and Citizens Utilities Company of California. We have considered all of the allegations raised in the petitions and are of the opinion that good cause has been shown for granting a rehearing of D.84-02-065 limited to the issue of whether Guerneville Water District (GWD) should be ordered to convert its annual service charge into a monthly charge. Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a rehearing of D.84-02-065 is granted to Citizens Utilities Company of California, limited to the issue whether GWD should be ordered to restructure its tariff by converting its annual service charge into a monthly charge. The application for rehearing of Kathy Wyrick is denied.


