DECISION 84-03-110 AND
DENYING REHEARING

A petition for rehearing of D. 84-03-110 has been filed by Harbor Carriers, Inc. (Harbor). We have considered all of the allegations raised therein and are of the opinion that good cause for granting rehearing has not been shown.

However, D. 84-03-110 should be modified to correct a technical error as to the scope of Harbor's operating authority. Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision 84-03-110 is modified as follows:

Finding of Fact No. 7 is modified to read:

"7. Harbor's operating rights obtained prior to 1937 were defined in the 1937 decision and are limited as specified in that decision."

Finding of Fact No. 8 is modified to read:

"8. Harbor's operating rights as pertinent to this decision were defined in the 1937 decision as follows:

A general launch barge, tug and towboat business in 'on call' service for the transportation of passengers between points on San Francisco and San Pablo Bays and for the transportation of property between points on San Francisco, San Pablo and Suisun Bays and for the transportation of property in

lots of not less than 100 tons between all other points involved in these proceedings."

The first paragraph on page 18 of the decision is modified to read:

"The operating authority granted in the 1937 decision does not authorize passenger service between San Francisco and Sacramento, nor does any additional authority granted to Harbor."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that rehearing of D. 84-03-110, as modified herein, is denied.
