ORDER CORRECTING DECISION 84-04-008

By Decision (D.) 84-04-008, dated April 4, 1984, we
 modified certain parts of General Order (G.O.) 112-D to conform with
 changes to Title 49 CFR Part 192, the Minimum Federal Safety
 Standards, issued by Materials Transportation Bureau, Department of
 Transportation. The decision inadvertently left out certain wording
 which we intended to include in Section 192.465(a) of G.O. 112-D.

We find and conclude that the underlined words should be included in Section 192.465(a), as follows:

"§192.465 External corrosion control: monitoring.

- (a) Each pipeline that is under cathodic protection must be tested within the period from the month preceding to the month following the annual anniversary, to determine whether the cathodic protection meets the requirements of Sec. 192.463. However, if tests at those intervals are impractical for separately protected short sections of mains or transmission lines, not in excess of 100 feet, or separately protected service lines, these pipelines may be surveyed on a sampling basis. At least 10 percent of these protected structures, distributed over the entire system must be surveyed each calendar year, with a different 10 percent checked each subsequent year, so that the entire system is tested in each 10-year period."

IT IS ORDERED that Section 192.465(a) of General Order 112-D is amended to include the additional words shown above.

This order becomes effective 30 days from today.
