ORDER OF DISMISSAL

In Application (A.) 82-08-33 California Manufacturers
Association (CMA) seeks the cancellation of all transition tariffs
provided in Decision (D.) 90663 dated August 14, 1979 in Case (C.) 5432,
Petition 884 et al. The transition tariffs, which canceled the former
general commodity minimum rate tariffs, were to apply during a transition
period of indefinite length. After conclusion of the transition period,
motor carriers would be free to establish their own rates without
reference to rate levels maintained by other carriers. CMA seeks to end
the transition period by canceling the transition tariffs.

In A.82-10-42, California Teamsters Public Affairs Council (Teamsters) seeks an order from the Commission directing its staff to develop new transition tariffs that will adequately reflect transportation costs and that will help to protect from unfair competition those carriers paying union wages and providing union benefits. Teamsters requests that its A.82-10-42 be joined with CMA's A.82-08-33 for hearing on a common record.

On May 16, 1984 the Commission issued Order Instituting Investigation (I.) 84-05-048 for the purpose of investigating the transportation reregulation programs advanced by CMA, Teamsters California Trucking Association, Ad Hoc Truckload Carrier Committee, and our staff, among others.

Because of the issuance of I.84-05-048, the issues raised by CMA in A.82-08-33 and by Teamsters in A.82-10-42 are moot, and those applications should be dismissed. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Applications 82-08-33 and 82-10-42 are dismissed.

This order is effective today.
