## <u>o p i n i o n</u>

This is an application by Miles Ramey seeking a dump truck carrier permit to operate in the Counties of Kern, Los Angeles, Ventura, and Santa Barbara.

Notice of the application appeared in the Commission's Daily Transportation Calendar on March 5, 1984. There are no protests.

The Commission makes the following findings and conclusion: Findings of Fact

- 1. A public hearing is not necessary in this matter.
- 2. Ramey was a resident of the State of California for 90 days preceding the filing of this application.
- 3. There is no derogatory information about Ramey in the record. He is a fit and proper person to receive a permit to operate as a dump truck carrier.
- 4. Ramey has seven years experience in the dump truck business. He has also operated a sump cleaning business for seven years.
- 5. Ramey had a net, worth of \$54,400 as of February 4, 1984. He has two powered dump truck vehicles. The vehicles are periodically inspected.
- 6. Ramey has sufficient operating knowledge and financial ability to initiate and continue the proposed operation.
- 7. The proposed operation will not endanger the safety of the public or interfere with the public use of the public highways or impair the condition or maintenance of them, directly or indirectly.

- 8. The proposed operation will not unnecessarily burden the public highways.
- 9. There are no protests to this application. Four shippers have filed certifications of support for the application indicating they would use Ramey's service if the operating authority sought herein is granted.
- 10. The authority sought herein is necessary to serve the public and will not impair the ability of presently permitted dump truck carriers to provide adequate service at the lowest possible reasonable rates.
- 11. It can be seen with reasonable certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment.
- 12. The effective date of this order should be the date hereof in order that applicant may provide needed services as dump truck carrier as soon as possible.

## Conclusion of Law

The application should be granted.

## ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The Executive Director shall issue a permit to operate as a dump truck carrier as defined in Section 3520 of the Public Utilities Code, to Miles Ramey authorizing operations in the Counties of Kern, Los Angeles, Ventura, and Santa Barbara when he has complied with the provisions of General Order Series 100.

2. The application is granted as set forth above.

This order is effective today.
