BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALLFORNIAL COLUMN

In the matter of the Application of Thomas J. Jernigan doing business as Jernigan Backhoe & (sic) Loader Service for authority to obtain a Dump Truck Carrier Permit to operate in the Counties of Plumas, Lassen, Sierra, Nevada, Placer, Yuba, Sutter, Butte and Tehama.

Application 84-03-75 (Filed March 22, 1984)

OPINION

Thomas J. Jernigan (applicant), dba Jernigan Backhoe & Loader Service, requests a dump truck carrier permit to operate in the Counties of Plumas, Lassen, Sierra, Nevada, Placer, Yuba, Sutter, Butte, and Tehama. Notice of the filing of the application appeared in the Daily Transportation Calendar of March 28, 1984. No protests have been filed.

Discussion

Applicant holds other permit authority (T-137719). He claims a net worth of \$86,207. He owns a powered end dump unit. Findings of Fact

1. Applicant:

- a. Is a fit and proper person to receive a permit to operate as a dump truck carrier.
- b. Has sufficient operating knowledge and financial ability to initiate and continue the proposed operation.

- c. Has demonstrated that the privilege sought:
 - (1) Will not endanger the safety of the public or interfere with the public use of the public highways or impair the condition or maintenance of them, directly or indirectly.
 - (2) Will not unnecessarily burden the public highways.
 - (3) Is necessary to serve the public and will not impair the ability of presently permitted dump truck carriers to provide adequate service at the lowest possible reasonable rates.
- 2. Applicant has resided in the State of California for at least the 90 days preceding the filing of this application.
- 3. It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment.
- 4. The following order complies with the Commission's Energy Efficiency Plan.
- 5. A public hearing is not necessary. Conclusions of Law
- 1. Applicant should be granted a dump truck carrier permit authorizing operations within and between points in the Counties of Plumas, Lassen, Sierra, Nevada, Placer, Yuba, Sutter, Butte, and Tehama.
- 2. The following order should be effective today to be consistent with other permit grants.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that the Executive Director shall issue a dump truck carrier permit to Thomas J. Jernigan, authorizing operations within and between points in the Counties of Plumas, Lassen, Sierra, Nevada, Placer, Yuba, Sutter, Butte, and Tehama upon compliance with General Order Series 100.

This order is effective today.
