<u>opinion</u>

James C. Geddes, an individual, doing business as J. C. Geddes Trucking, requests a dump truck carrier permit to operate in the counties of San Diego, Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside, San Bernardino, and Imperial. Notice of the filing of the application appeared in the Commission's Daily Transportation Calendar of April 17, 1984. No protests have been received.

The application is supported by Terra Trucking Company, an overlying carrier, who expects to use applicant to subhaul approximately 1,500 hours per year. Applicant's balance sheet as of March 21, 1984 shows a net worth of \$38,973. Findings of Fact

1. Applicant:

- a. Is a fit and proper individual to receive a permit to operate as a dump truck carrier.
- b. Has sufficient operating knowledge and financial ability to initiate and continue the proposed operation.

- c. Has demonstrated that the privilege sought:
 - (1) Will not endanger the safety of the public or interfere with the public use of the public highways or impair the condition or maintenance of them, directly or indirectly.
 - (2) Will not unnecessarily burden the public highways.
 - (3) Is necessary to serve the public and will not impair the ability of presently permitted dump truck carriers to provide adequate service at the lowest possible reasonable rates.
- 2. Applicant has resided in the State of California for at least the 90 days preceding the filing of this application.
- 3. It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment.
- 4. The following order complies with the Commission's Energy Efficiency Plan.
- 5. A public hearing is not necessary. Conclusions of Law
- 1. Applicant should be granted a dump truck carrier permit authorizing operations within and between points in the counties of San Diego, Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside, San Bernardino, and Imperial.
- 2. The following order should be effective today to be consistent with other permit grants.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that the Executive Director shall issue a dump truck carrier permit to James C. Geddes, authorizing operations within and between points in the counties of San Diego, Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside, San Bernardino, and Imperial upon compliance with General Order Series 100.

This order is effective today.
