ORDER MODIFYING DECISION 84-02-002

Comven, Inc. (Comven) petitions to modify Decision (D.) 84-02-002 to correct an alleged factual error concerning Comven's expected startup capital needs for construction of the radiotelephone system authorized in that decision. Finding of Fact 4 in that decision states that "Applicant expects its startup capital needs for the proposed service to total \$753,700".

In its Petition Comven states that application (A.) 83-06-39 was filed the same day as the pending Comven A.83-06-38 with respect to provision of a similar service in San Diego. systems that Comven filed for on that day, as well as others it has proposed, will be virtually identical in terms of Federal Communications Commission (FCC) approval, engineering, operation, and cost. Because the two applications were so similar and were filed the same day, they were treated as a single system or "package" both for purposes of internal planning and presentation of financial information with seeking certification. Therefore, the same projections concerning capital requirements, expense and income were combined in the exhibits filed with both applications. As a matter of fact, the \$753,700 capital requirement jointly considers the capital requirements for the two systems and three other systems as well which Comven expects to install. Therefore, the \$753,700 should be divided by five to reflect applicant's expectations with respect

to the facility dealt with in D.84-02-002. To correct this alleged error applicant requests that Finding of Fact 4 be modified. For good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Finding of Fact 4 in D.84-02-002 which presently reads as follows:

"4. Applicant expects its start-up capital needs for the proposed services to total \$753,700."

is modified to read as follows:

"4. Applicant expects its startup capital needs for three applications it has filed and two more it plans to file to total \$753,700, and for capital needs for the service in San Bernardino, which is the only service considered by this decision, to be approximately one-fifth of that amount."


