In the matter of the Application of Joseph Anthony Stella doing business as Joe's Equipment for authority to obtain a Dump Truck Carrier Permit to operate in the Counties of Placer, Sacramento, El Dorado, Alpine, Sierra, Nevada, Lassen, Plumas, Yolo, Butte, Yuba, Sutter, Colusa, Amador, Shasta, and Modoc.

O P I N I O N

Joseph Anthony Stella (applicant), dba Joe's Equipment, requests a dump truck carrier permit to operate in the Counties of Placer, El Dorado, Sacramento, Alpine, Sierra, Nevada, Lassen, Plumas, Yolo, Butte, Yuba, Sutter, Colusa, Amador, Shasta, and Modoc. Notice of the filing of the application appeared in the Daily Transportation Calendar of March 26, 1984. No protests have been filed.

Discussion

Applicant owns a dump truck with transfer type trailer. He presently holds no operating authority from this Commission. He claims a net worth of nearly \$1.5 million; included in his assets are approximately \$14,000 in cash or bank accounts.

Findings of Fact

1. Applicant:
 - a. Is a fit and proper person to receive a permit to operate as a dump truck carrier.
 - b. Has sufficient operating knowledge and financial ability to initiate and continue the proposed operation.

c. Has demonstrated that the privilege sought:

- (1) Will not endanger the safety of the public or interfere with the public use of the public highways or impair the condition or maintenance of them, directly or indirectly.
- (2) Will not unnecessarily burden the public highways.
- (3) Is necessary to serve the public and will not impair the ability of presently permitted dump truck carriers to provide adequate service at the lowest possible reasonable rates.

2. Applicant has resided in the State of California for at least the 90 days preceding the filing of this application.

3. It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment.

4. The following order complies with the Commission's Energy Efficiency Plan.

5. A public hearing is not necessary.

Conclusions of Law

1. Applicant should be granted a dump truck carrier permit authorizing operations within and between points in the Counties of Placer, El Dorado, Sacramento, Alpine, Sierra, Nevada, Lassen, Plumas, Yolo, Butte, Yuba, Sutter, Colusa, Amador, Shasta, and Modoc.

2. The following order should be effective today to be consistent with other permit grants.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The Executive Director shall issue a dump truck carrier permit to Joseph Anthony Stella, authorizing operations within and between points in the Counties of Placer, El Dorado, Sacramento, Alpine, Sierra, Nevada, Lassen, Plumas, Yolo, Butte, Yuba, Sutter, Colusa, Amador, Shasta, and Modoc upon compliance with General Order Series 100.

2. The application is granted as set forth above.

This order is effective today.


