ORDER CORRECTING CLERICAL ERROR

The Commission has been informed that there was an inadvertent error in the ordering paragraph of Decision 93565, issued September 15, 1981.

Cement contract carrier permits are issued authorizing operations from all points of origin in the State of California to certain named counties. By error, a permit was granted by the above decision authorizing operations only within and between the Counties of Butte, Placer, and Sacramento to James M. Milham, File T-97,132.


In accordance with Resolution A-4661,

IT IS ORDERED that Decision 93565 is hereby amended by substituting the following ordering paragraph in the place of the existing ordering paragraph.

IT IS ORDERED that upon applicant's compliance with the Commission's General Order Series 100, the Executive Director shall issue a cement contract carrier permit to James M. Milham authorizing operations from all points within the State of California to all points in the Counties of Butte, Placer, and Sacramento.
