ORDER OF EXEMPTION

C & H Transportation, Inc. (C & H) requests an order exempting it from the provisions of Public Utilities (PU) Code Sections 816-830 pursuant to Section 829 and from the provisions of PU Code Sections 851-855 pursuant to Section 853. This exemption would cover the sale and issuance of equity and debt securities, revolving credit agreements, and other evidences of indebtedness.

Notice of the filing of the application appeared on the Commission's Daily Calendar of April 27, 1984. No protests have been received.

This decision meets the criteria set forth in Resolution F-607. This resolution provides that transportation utilities may be granted exemptions if their intrastate revenues are less than 5% of their gross annual revenues.

Under Resolution F-607

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. C & H Transportation, Inc. (C & H) is exempt from the provisions of Public Utilities (PU) Code Sections 816 through 830 and 851 through 855. This exemption is granted for a two-year period commencing with the effective date of this order.
2. C & H shall file the reports required by General Order Series 24.
3. Concurrent with the filing of the reports required by General Order Series 24, C & H shall pay the fees set by PU Code Sections 1904(b) and 1904.1, for all securities issued during the two-year period this exemption remains in effect.
4. The application is granted as set forth above.

This order is effective today.
