SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

A decision dated today in this proceeding found that rates and charges in Minimum Rate Tariff 20 (MRT 20) should be made subject to an increase of ten percentage points, and amendment of the tariff should be accomplished by separate order.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. MRT 20 (Appendix A to Decision (D.) 81799, as amended) is further amended by incorporating Supplement 21, attached, to become effective July 9, 1984.

2. Common carriers subject to the Public Utilities Act, to the extent that they also are subject to D.81799, as amended, are directed to establish in their tariffs the increases necessary to conform with the further adjustments ordered by this decision.

3. Common carrier tariff publications made as a result of this order which involve increases shall be effective not earlier than July 9, 1984.

4. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the rates authorized by this order, are authorized to depart from the provisions of Public Utilities Code § 461.5 to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under

outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the rates published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

5. In all other respects, D.81799, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

6. The Executive Director shall serve a copy of this decision on every common carrier, or such carriers' authorized tariff publishing agents, performing transportation services subject to MRT 20.

7. The Executive Director shall serve a copy of the tariff amendments on each subscriber to MRT 20.

8. Petition for Modification 23 in Case 9820 is granted as set forth above.

2. By thirty-three and one-half (33-1/2) percent on all other rates and charges.

For purposes of disposing of fractions under provisions hereof. fractions of less than one-half (1/2) cent shall be dropped and fractions of one-half (1/2) cent or greater shall be increased to the next higher whole cent.

EXCEPTION: The surcharge herein shall not apply to Item 280 - Collect on Delivery (C.O.D.) Shipment.
