O P I N I O N

James F. Eberwein and Jill E. Eberwein (applicants) seek authorization to acquire control of Clovis Stone & Supply, Inc. (CSS), a California corporation. Applicants allege that they have contracted to purchase all outstanding shares of CSS for \$225,000.

CSS is a highway common carrier pursuant to Public Utilities Code § 1063.5 and also holds a dump truck carrier permit issued in File T-121,120. A balance sheet submitted with the application shows total assets of \$403,182 and stockholders' equity of \$29,900 as of October 31, 1983. A copy of CSS's articles of incorporation is attached to the application.

Notice of the filing of the application appeared in the Commission's Daily Transportation Calendar on March 29, 1984, and it was served upon the California Trucking Association. No protests have been received.

Findings of Fact

1. Acquisition of control of CSS by applicants is not adverse to the public interest.
2. A public hearing is not required.
3. It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the granting of this application may have a significant effect on the environment.

Conclusion of Law

The application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. James F. Eberwein and Jill E. Eberwein are authorized to acquire control of Clovis Stone & Supply, Inc. by acquisition of all of the corporation's outstanding shares. Applicants shall file written notice that the acquisition is completed within 30 days of the acquisition.

2. The application is granted as set forth above.

This order becomes effective 30 days from today.


