<u>O P I N I O N</u>

Mammoth Firewood Company, Inc., a California corporation, requests a dump truck carrier permit to operate in the Counties of Mono and Inyo. Notice of the filing of the application appeared in the Daily Transportation Calendar of May 16, 1984. No protests have been filed.

Discussion

Applicant holds no other authority. The application is supported by three shippers each of which will need transportation services four hours per week. It owns a tractor and three dump trailers. As of February 1984 it had a net worth of \$215,000. Findings of Fact

1. Applicant:

- a. Is a fit and proper corporation to receive a permit to operate as a dump truck carrier.
- b. Has sufficient operating knowledge and financial ability to initiate and continue the proposed operation.
- c. Has demonstrated that the privilege sought:
 - (1) Will not endanger the safety of the public or interfere with the public use of the public highways or impair the condition or maintenance of them, directly or indirectly.
 - (2) Will not unnecessarily burden the public highways.
 - (3) Is necessary to serve the public and will not impair the ability of

presently permitted dump truck carriers to provide adequate service at the lowest possible reasonable rates.

2. Applicant is a California corporation.

3. It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment.

4. The following order complies with the Commission's Energy Efficiency Plan.

5. A public hearing is not necessary.

Conclusions of Law

1. Applicant should be granted a dump truck carrier permit authorizing operations within and between points in the Counties of Mono and Inyo.

2. The following order should be effective today to be consistent with other permit grants.
