O P I N I O N

Sierra Construction & Equipment Rental (applicant), a California corporation, has applied for a dump truck carrier permit to authorize operation in the Counties of Inyo and Mono. Notice of the filing of the application appeared in the Daily Transportation Calendar on May 29, 1984. No protests have been filed.

Certificates supporting the application were filed by Valley Paving, Inc. and Nikolaus Tank Lines, Inc. of Bishop, California, stating that applicant's service would be employed in the two counties it seeks to serve. It was estimated that \$42,000 worth of hauling would be handled by applicant in the first year.

Applicant's balance sheet dated May 11, 1984 lists assets of \$988,728, liabilities of \$99,106, and a net worth of \$889,622.

Findings of Fact

1. Applicant:
 - a. Is a fit and proper entity to receive a permit to operate as a dump truck carrier.
 - b. Has sufficient operating knowledge and financial ability to initiate and continue the proposed operation.

c. Has demonstrated that the privilege sought:

- (1) Will not endanger the safety of the public or interfere with the public use of the public highways or impair the condition or maintenance of them, directly or indirectly.
- (2) Will not unnecessarily burden the public highways.
- (3) Is necessary to serve the public and will not impair the ability of presently permitted dump truck carriers to provide adequate service at the lowest possible reasonable rates.

2. It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment.

3. The following order complies with the Commission's Energy Efficiency Plan.

4. A public hearing is not necessary.

Conclusions of Law

1. Applicant should be granted a dump truck carrier permit authorizing operations within and between points in the Counties of Inyo and Mono.

2. The following order should be effective today to be consistent with other permit grants.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that the Executive Director shall issue a dump truck carrier permit to Sierra Construction & Equipment Rental authorizing operations within and between points in the Counties of Inyo and Mono upon compliance with General Order Series 100.

This order is effective today.


