O P I N I O N

Worden's East-West Line, Inc., a California corporation, seeks authority pursuant to Public Utilities (PU) Code § 1031 to operate as a passenger stage corporation, as defined in PU Code § 226, between Camp Pendleton Marine Base in the County of San Diego and the San Diego International Airport.

In support of its request, applicant provides the following information:

Service is proposed on a regularly scheduled seven-day per week basis. Only passengers originating at or destined to the San Diego International Airport will be carried.

The vehicle used will be a 1965 Ford 36-passenger bus insured in amounts in excess of Commission requirements. The vehicle will be garaged and serviced at applicant's facilities located in Santee, California.

Applicant's financial statement shows assets of \$10,550 and no liabilities as of April 15, 1984.

Notice of filing of the application appeared in the Commission's Daily Transportation Calendar of May 24, 1984. No objection to the request has been received.

Findings of Fact

1. Applicant has the ability and financial resources to perform the proposed service.

2. It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment.

Conclusion of Law

The application should be granted as set forth in the order. Since there are no protests, the order should become effective on the date it is signed.

Only the amount paid to the State for operative rights may be used in rate fixing. The State may grant any number of rights and may cancel or modify these rights at any time.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. A certificate of public convenience and necessity is granted to Worden's East-West Line, Inc., a California corporation, authorizing it to operate as a passenger stage corporation, as defined in PU Code § 226, between the points and over the route set forth in Appendix PSC-1345, to transport persons and baggage.

2. Applicant shall:

- a. File a written acceptance of this certificate within 30 days after this order is effective.
- b. Establish the authorized service and file tariffs and timetables within 120 days after this order is effective.
- c. State in its tariffs and timetables when service will start; allow at least 10 days' notice to the Commission; and make timetables and tariffs effective 10 or more days after this order is effective.
- d. Comply with General Orders Series 79, 98, 101, and 104, and the California Highway Patrol safety rules.
- e. Maintain accounting records in conformity with the Uniform System of Accounts.

f. Remit to the Commission the Transportation Reimbursement Fee required by PU Code § 403 when notified by mail to do so.

3. Prior to initiating service to any airport, applicant shall notify the airport authority involved. This certificate does not authorize the holder to conduct any operations on the property of or into any airport unless such operation is authorized by both this Commission and the airport authority involved.

4. Applicant is authorized to begin operations on the date that the Executive Director mails a notice to applicant that it has evidence of insurance on file with the Commission and that the California Highway Patrol has approved the use of applicant's vehicles for service.

5. The application is granted as set forth above.

This order is effective today.



SECTION 1. GENERAL AUTHORIZATIONS, RESTRICTIONS, LIMITATIONS,
AND SPECIFICATIONS.

Worden's East-West Line, Inc., by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by the decision noted in the margin, is authorized as a passenger stage corporation to transport passengers, their baggage and express between the San Diego International Airport (SAN) and Camp Pendleton Marine Corps Base, subject, however, to the authority of this Commission to change or modify this authority at any time and subject to the following provisions:

- a. All transportation of passengers shall originate at and shall be destined to the service points specified in Section 2.
- b. When route descriptions are given in one direction, they apply to operation in either direction unless otherwise indicated.
- c. Prior to initiating service to any airport, applicants shall notify the airport authority involved. This certificate does not authorize the holder to conduct any operations on the property of or into any airport unless such operation is authorized by both this Commission and the airport authority involved.

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SECTION 2. ROUTE DESCRIPTIONS.

Route 1. San Diego International Airport-Camp Pendleton

Commencing with service point at the following location:

San Diego International Airport

Then via the most appropriate streets and highways to service point at the following location:

Camp Pendleton Marine Corps Base, Oceanside

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
