## ORDER DISCONTINUING INVESTIGATION AND VACATING SUSPENSION OF RATE REDUCTION 1705

By letter dated April 26, 1984, the Director of the Transportation Division, under authority of Resolution M-4713, suspended the rates contained in RR 1705. The suspension of 45 days was made following additional review of the cost justification by the staff.

Cascade Drayage and Warehousing, Inc. (Cascade) failed to adequately respond to the staff's request for additional data justifying the reasonableness of RR 1705. The staff then recommended that an I & S proceeding be entered into the rates in RR 1705 and an order (I & S) C.84-06-013 was issued on June 6, 1984 extending the suspension of RR 1705.

Cascade has submitted additional data justifying the reasonableness of RR 1705 which the staff has reviewed and found to be satisfactory and recommends that the I & S proceeding be vacated and that the suspension of the rates in RR 1705 be lifted.

## IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. The investigation instituted on the Commission's own motion into the rates proposed by Cascade Drayage and Warehousing, Inc. in Rate Reduction 1705 is discontinued.
- 2. The suspension of rates contained in Rate Reduction 1705, is vacated.

This order is effective today.
