International Air Service Company, Limited (applicant) has applied for a Class B charter-party certificate (§ 5351 et seq., Public Utilities (PU) Code). We take official notice that applicant already holds a charter-party permit issued under PU Code § 5384(a).

Our staff has investigated the background of this application.¹ It was apparently filed at the insistence of San Francisco Airport (SFO) police officers who have suggested that it may be unlawful for applicant, under its permit, to pick up passengers at the airport.

Applicant operates a commercial school for airline employees in Napa. The service is provided under a contract with the students' employer. Its only transportation function is to pick up incoming class members at SFO, transport them to Napa and back again when the session is completed. All passengers are students at the school. Applicant does not engage in any business under which it charters its bus to any other individual or group. Finding of Fact and Conclusions of Law

We find that applicant transports only its own students. We conclude as a matter of law that applicant already possesses

sufficient operating authority to conduct the transportation operations discussed above. We further conclude that it does not require Class B charter-party authority to conduct such operations. Since this application was filed when it was not necessary, it should be dismissed without prejudice and applicant's filing fee should be returned.
