ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Applicant, the United States of America (Government), has filed a written request dated July 17, 1984 to withdraw this application.

The written request of withdrawal is conditioned upon our staff not objecting to Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) connecting electric service to the Government's overhead lines on its own property. By letter of July 20, 1984 our staff informed PG&E and the Government that it had no objection to PG&E making the connection provided that the part of the proposed line that is visible from Highway 49 (designated scenic highway) is placed underground.

IT IS ORDERED that Application 84-07-005 is dismissed.

This order is issued under Public Utilities Code § 308 and Resolution A-4638.
