## ORDER RESCINDING DECISION (D.) 84-07-068

On August 3, 1984 an application for rehearing of D.84-07-068 was jointly filed by the Cities of Los Angeles and San Diego (Cities). In reviewing the record underlying this decision it has come to our attention that copies were not mailed to parties in Application No. 55676 and related proceedings. This should have been done inasmuch as the decisions rescinded by D.84-07-068 were issued in those earlier proceedings.

We have concluded that the most appropriate means of correcting this deficiency is to rescind and then reissue D.84-07-068 with an order that copies thereof and of the Administrative Law Judge's proposed decision be mailed to all parties in A.55676, A.55677, A.55544 and A.55543 as well as the parties in this proceeding, with a letter of explanation. This will reestablish the 30 day period upon which the decision became effective and provide a uniform period during which applications for rehearing may be filed by any party.

Inasmuch as the Cities have already filed an application for rehearing of D.84-07-068, they may elect to have it considered as their application for rehearing of our new order reissuing that decision, or may file a new application within the period set by the new issue date (see Section 1733(b), Public Utilities Code). Therefore, good cause appearing.

IT IS ORDERED that,

1. D.84-07-068 is rescinded.

2. Copies of this order and of all subsequent orders in this proceeding shall be served by mail on all parties to Application Nos. 55676, 55677, 55544 and 55543, together with a letter of explanation that, although issued in this proceeding, it relates to those earlier proceedings as well.
