ORDER DISMISSING APPLICATION

Applicant Capitol City Transportation, Inc. requests a certificate to operate as a passenger stage corporation between points more particularly set out in the application. Applicant does not now hold any passenger stage certificate issued by the Commission.

Concurrent with the filing of its application, applicant gave a check for \$75 to the Commission as payment of the filing fee. On June 19, 1984 the drawee bank returned the \$75 check to the Commission. The check was marked "non sufficient funds". As of July 16, 1984 applicant had not made good on the check.

On July 16, 1984 the assigned Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) called applicant at the telephone number appearing in the application to inquire if applicant intended to make good on the check. The person answering the phone stated that he was not an employee of applicant but was answering the telephone on a volunteer basis. He stated that to his knowledge applicant was out of business and that the person who had signed the application was no longer with applicant.

On July 18, 1984 the ALJ wrote and mailed a letter to the applicant at applicant's address appearing in the application. In the letter the ALJ stated that if applicant did not make good the check in remitting to the Commission \$80 (\$75 filing fee plus \$5 returned charge) within 10 days of the date of the letter, the ALJ would recommend to the Commission that the application be dismissed. No response to the letter has been received by the Commission and no part of the application filing fee has been paid. Wherefore,


IT IS ORDERED that Application 84-06-008 is dismissed.
