SECTION 1. GENERAL AUTHORIZATIONS, RESTRICTIONS, LIMITATIONS, AND SPECIFICATIONS.

Antelope Valley Airport Express, Inc., by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by the decision noted in the margin, is authorized as a passenger stage comporation to transport passengers, *baggagerand express between Palmdalerand Lancaster, on the one hand, and the Los Angeles International Airport (LAX) on the other hand, subject, however, to the authority of this Commission to change or modify this authority at any time and subject to the following provisions:

- a. All transportation of passengers shall originate at and shall be destined to the service points specified in Section 2.
- b. When route descriptions are given in one direction, they apply to operation in either direction unless otherwise indicated.
