Application of PUROLATOR COURIER CORP. To Enter Into Industrial Revenue Bond Financing Agreement In Connection With The Financing of Terminal Facilities In Delaware County. Ohio.

ORDER OF EXEMPTION

Purolator Courier Corp. (Purolator) requests an order exempting it from the provisions of Public Utilities (PU) Code Sections 816-830 under Section 829 and from the provisions of PU Code Sections 851-855 under Section 853. This exemption would cover the issuance and sale of Industrial Revenue Bond(s) in connection with the financing of terminal facilities in Delaware County, Ohio.

Notice of the filing of the application appeared on the Commission's Daily Calendar of October 16, 1984. No protests have been received.

This decision meets the criteria set forth in Resolution F-607. This resolution provides that transportation utilities may be granted exemptions if their intrastate revenues are less than 5% of their gross annual revenues.

Under Resolution F-607
IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Purolator Courier Corp. (Purolator) is exempt from the provisions of Public Utilities (PU) Code Sections 816 through 830 and 851 through 855. This exemption is granted for a two-year period commencing with the effective date of this order.
- 2. Purolator shall file the reports requested by General Order Series 24.
- 3. Concurrent with the filing of the reports required by General Order Series 24, Purolator shall pay the fees set by PU Code Section 1904(b) for all securities issued during the two-year period this exemption remains in effect.
 - 4. The application is granted as set forth above.
