Mike Bomer requests a dump truck carrier permit to operate in the Counties of Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside, and San Bernardino. Notice of the filing of the application appeared in the Daily Transportation Calendar of June 15, 1984. No protests have been filed.

Applicant owns one power unit and one trailer. His net worth was \$101,460 as of May 16, 1984. Applicant executed a declaration, under penalty of perjury, certifying that he has been a resident of California for not less than 90 days preceding the filing of this application. Frank Smith Trucking & Equipment, Inc. filed a certificate in support of the application which indicates that if the requested permit is granted, it would use the services of applicant in each of the counties for which authority is sought. Findings of Fact

1. Applicant:

- a. Is a fit and proper person to receive a permit to operate as a dump truck carrier.
- b. Has sufficient operating knowledge and financial ability to initiate and continue the proposed operation.
- c. Has demonstrated that the privilege sought:
 - (1) Will not endanger the safety of the public or interfere with the public use of the public highways or impair the condition or maintenance of them, directly or indirectly.

- (2) Will not unnecessarily burden the public highways.
- (3) Is necessary to serve the public and will not impair the ability of presently permitted dump truck carriers to provide adequate service at the lowest possible reasonable rates.

2. Applicant has resided in the State of California for at least the 90 days preceding the filing of this application.

3. It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment.

4. The following order complies with the Commission's Energy Efficiency Plan.

5. A public hearing is not necessary. Conclusions of Law

1. Applicant should be granted a dump truck carrier permit authorizing operations within and between points in the Counties of Orange, Los Angeles, Riverside, and San Bernardino.

2. The following order should be effective today to be consistent with other permit grants.
