ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Wolfe Services, Inc. by this application requests authority to publish a new item in its Adoption Notice to the Commission's Transition Tariff 2 which would establish rates for "Freight All Kinds" which is palletized and shrink wrapped. The proposed charges are stated in units of dollars-per-pallet, and apply statewide.

While the proposed rates will result in increased charges in some instances, they would also result in reductions to below the transition tariff level in many cases. Applicant was advised by letter dated August 6, 1984 from the Commission staff to amend the application to address the fact that reductions as well as increases would result from the proposed rates, and to concurrently file a rate justification statement pursuant to the requirements of General Order 147 with operational and cost data to show that the rates would contribute to profitability. Applicant has not responded to this request.

Findings of Fact

1. The proposed rates would result not only in increases, but also in reductions to below the level of the rates and charges in the Commission's Transition Tariff 2.

2. This matter should have been concurrently filed as a rate reduction request under the provisions of General Order 147.

3. The application should address the fact that both increases and reductions would result from the proposed rates.

Conclusion of Law

The application should be dismissed without prejudice to applicant's refiling a new application and rate reduction request under General Order 147 with proper supporting documentation.


IT IS ORDERED that Shortened Procedure Tariff Docket Application 84-07-010 is dismissed without prejudice.
