Applicant Jak Van Nada had requested authority to deviate from the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariff 4-B naming rates for the transportation of used household goods.


By letter dated October 25, 1984 applicant has informed the Administrative Law Judge to whom this matter was referred that he wishes to withdraw his application.
