ORDER MODIFYING DECISION 84-08-085

By Decision (D.) 84-08-085 dated August 1, 1984 in Application (A.) 84-05-098, Golden Coachcraft Limousine Service, Inc. (GCLS) was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity (CPC&N) to establish and operate a passenger stage bus service between points in Los Angeles and Orange counties, on the one hand, and several Southern California airports, on the other hand.

It has been brought to our attention by GCLS in a petition for modification that on Original Pages 2 and 3 of Appendix PSC-1355, attached to D.84-08-085, the Long Beach Airport (LBA) was omitted as one of the airport terminals to which GCLS was authorized to pick up and drop off passengers. LBA was included as a terminal point in A.84-08-098, but was omitted from the CPC&N through inadvertence. Accordingly, D.84-08-085 should be modified by revising Original Pages 2 and 3 of Appendix PSC-1355.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Apperdx PSC-1355 attached to D.84-08-085 is modified as set forth on First Revised Page 2 and First Revised Page 3 attached hereto which cancel original pages 2 and 3, respectively.

2. In all other respects, D.84-08-085 shall remain in full force and effect.



**SECTION 1. GENERAL AUTHORIZATIONS, RESTRICTIONS, LIMITATIONS,
AND SPECIFICATIONS.**

Golden Coachcraft Limousine Service, Inc., by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by the decision noted in the margin, is authorized to transport passengers and baggage "on-call" between points in Los Angeles and Orange counties, on the one hand, and Los Angeles International Airport (LAX), Long Beach Airport (LGB*), Burbank-Glendale-Pasadena Airport (BUR), Ontario International Airport (ONT), Orange County/John Wayne Airport (SNA) and the piers and docks in the Long Beach and Los Angeles harbors, on the other hand, over and along the routes described, subject, however, to the authority of this Commission to change or modify the routes at any time and subject to the following provisions:

- a. Motor vehicles may be turned at termini and intermediate points, in either direction, at intersections of streets or by operating around a block contiguous to such intersections, in accordance with local traffic regulations.
- b. When route descriptions are given in one direction, they apply to operation in either direction unless otherwise indicated.
- c. The term "on-call" as used refers to service which is authorized to be rendered dependent on the demands of passengers. The tariffs and timetables shall show the conditions under which each authorized "on-call" service will be rendered.
- d. No passengers shall be transported except those having point of origin or destination at LAX, LGB*, BUR, ONT, SNA or the piers and docks in Long Beach or Los Angeles harbors.
- e. This certificate does not authorize the holder to conduct any operations on the property of or into any airport unless such operation is authorized by both this Commission and the airport authority involved.

SECTION 2. ROUTE DESCRIPTION.

Commencing at LAX, LGB*, BUR, ONT, SNA or the piers and docks in Long Beach or Los Angeles harbors then over and along the most convenient streets and highways to any point within the authorized service territory described in Section 3.

SECTION 3. AUTHORIZED SERVICE TERRITORY.

All points in Los Angeles County south of the Los Angeles National Forest and State Highway 118 and all points within Orange County.
