## ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On August 5, 1987 the Commission's Transportation Division staff, under delegated authority, suspended the effective date of the rates in cost justification CJ 87-142, filed by California Transportation Network, Inc. The suspension resulted from a protest to the cost justification, filed by the law office of Skaff & Anderson on behalf of Yandell Truckaway and Anello Trucking Company.

On September 10, 1987, the Commission instituted investigation and continued the suspension of the rates in CJ 87-142 for no more than 120 days.

California Transportation Network, Inc. through its agent, Western Traffic Services, Inc., has requested that CJ 87-142 be withdrawn without prejudice. The withdrawal renders moot the protest and also the investigation in C.87-09-011. T/AH/1gg C.87-09-011

IT IS ORDERED that Case 87-09-011 is dismissed under Public Utilities Code Section 308 and Resolution A-4638.
