ORDER MODIFYING D.87-07-022 AND DENYING REHEARING

TOM-SON TANK LINES, INC. (Tom-Son) has filed an application for rehearing of Decision (D.) 87-07-022. We have considered all the allegations of error in the application and are of the opinion that good cause for rehearing has not been shown. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. Rehearing of D.87-07-022 is hereby denied.
- 2. D.87-07-022 is hereby modified as follows:
 - a. The first two sentences of the first full paragraph of page 13 are modified to read:

"The Commission has recently interpreted new legislation on the granting of certificates of public convenience and necessity for cement hauling. That interpretation was made in a decision denying an application to expand a cement certificate authority from 2 to 14 counties."

b. Conclusion of law No. 1 of D.87-07-022 is modified to read:

"Applicant has failed to show a need for the proposed service, and has failed to rebut protestants' evidence that said service, if authorized, would impair the ability of existing carriers to provide adequate service at the lowest possible reasonable rates."

This order is effective today.
