ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Applicant Lord & Miner, Incorporated, a California corporation doing business as Blue & Gold Cab & Para-Transit Lines, seeks a certificate of public convenience and necessity (CPC&N) to operate as a passenger stage corporation to transport passengers and their baggage between Lancaster and Victorville, with intermediate pick-up and discharge points in Palmdale, Little Rock, and Pearblossom. ✓

Because of the receipt of evidence by the Commission staff of the unlawful extensions of applicant's then present passenger stage certificate, action on Application (A.) 86-01-015 was withheld pending investigation.

By Decision (D.) 87-07-014 in A.86-04-055 and related matters in Case 86-03-044 and Case 86-04-028, the Commission revoked applicant's CPC&N. In view of the Commission's action in those cases, A.86-01-015 should be dismissed.

Finding of Fact

D.87-07-014 issued July 8, 1987 revoked the CPC&N previously issued to applicant.

Conclusion of Law

Given the fact that applicant's CPC&N has been revoked by the Commission, A.86-01-015 should be dismissed.

IT IS ORDERED that A.86-01-015 is dismissed.
