ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Consolidated Telenet, Inc. (applicant) filed this application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a reseller of interLATA telecommunication services.

By letter dated May 27, 1987 the Telecommunication Section of the Commission Advisory and Compliance Division (CACD) confirmed a May 21, 1987 telephone conversation with applicant that applicant planned to file bankruptcy in May 1987 and requested written confirmation of such intention with the request to withdraw the application.

Subsequent to the May 27, 1987 letter, repeated attempts have been made by the CACD to contact applicant. These attempts have been without success.

Since the applicant is not available and has shown no interest in pursuing the application, we conclude that the applicant is no longer interested in the application and that the application should be dismissed for lack of prosecution.

IT IS ORDERED that Application 87-03-002 is dismissed without prejudice.
