ORDER GRANTING LIMITED REHEARING
OF DECISION (D.) 87-12-066

Petitions for rehearing of D.87-12-066 have been filed by San Diego Gas & Electric Co. (SDG&E), Western Mobilehome Association (WMA) and Richard Wesselink and Norman Tolstad dba Lake Park Resort et al. We have carefully considered the allegations contained in the petitions and are of the opinion that a rehearing should be granted, limited to the issue whether SDG&E and Pacific Gas & Electric Co. should be required to use the ELFIN computer model to develop base case production costing runs in their future general rate cases, ECACs, and OIR-2 related proceedings. With respect to the petition filed by WMA, we emphasize that Edison has already been directed to derive diversity factors for its next general rate case based on the usage pattern of mobile home parks which it individually meters. Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Rehearing is granted, limited to the issue whether SDG&E and PG&E should be required to use the ELFIN computer model to develop base case production costing runs in their future general rate cases, ECACs, and OIR-2 related proceedings.

2. Except as granted as provided herein, rehearing of D.87-12-066 is denied. The petitions for rehearing filed by WMA and Lake Park Resort et al. are denied in their entirety.

This order is effective today.
