
ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Applicant, by letter dated February 17, 1988 requests an extension of time to June 30, 1990, to comply with the provisions of Decisions 83-03-056 and 86-04-001. The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company has indicated by letter dated March 24, 1988 that it has no objection to the requested extension of time. There has been no substantial change in circumstances since the original authority was granted by previous Commission decisions.

IT IS ORDERED that the City of Irvine is granted an extension of time until June 30, 1990 to exercise the authority granted by Decisions 83-03-056 and 86-04-001. In all other respects, Decision 83-03-056, which decision granted the original authority, shall remain in full force and effect.


This order is issued under authority of Resolution ET-1367 and is effective today.
