

ORDER OF DISMISSAL


Southern California Edison Company (Edison) seeks to withdraw a Petition For Modification of Decision 82-01-18 filed on January 29, 1987. This petition sought to modify the formula for allocating Rule 20A funds among the cities and counties in Edison's service territory. The modified allocation formula was developed by the League of California Cities (League) and was submitted to the Commission by Edison at the League's request. The League subsequently has requested that Edison withdraw the petition while alternative allocation methods are considered.

Therefore, Edison's Petition For Modification of Decision 82-01-18 is dismissed under Public Utilities Code Section 308 and Resolution A-4638, effective today.
