ORDER OF DISMISSAL

The complaint alleges that defendant Pacific Bell overcharged complainant Chen Wang \$11,000 for 14 telephone lines installed without complainant's authorization. Pacific Bell answered, denying the material allegations of the complaint and alleging that defendant owed it \$11,812.26. Complainant deposited the latter sum with the Commission.

The matter was properly noticed for hearing before Administrative Law Judge Gilman on April 19, 1988 in San Francisco. Counsel for defendant appeared to announce that the matter had been settled.

The matter was taken under submission, with the parties to file formal settlement documents when completed. On May 9, we received a letter signed by defendant's attorney authorizing release of all funds on deposit to complainant.

Since this matter is settled, no findings or conclusions are required.

IT IS ORDERED that:


1. Case 87-12-047 is dismissed under Public Utilities Code Section 308 and Resolution A-4638.
