INTERIM ORDER PROHIBITING CUSTOMER DISCONNECTS FOR NONPAYMENT OF THE \$82.18 SURCHARGE FOR WATER HAULAGE

CAMP MEEKER RECREATION AND PARKS DISTRICT (District) has filed an application for rehearing of Decision (D.) 87-10-087, in which the Commission approved \$29,091 in water hauling expenses incurred by Camp Meeker Water System, Inc. (CMWSI) from June 24, 1987 through November 30, 1987. Without determining the merits of the application for rehearing, we hereby issue an interim order prohibiting CMWSI from discontinuing service to those customers of CMWSI who have failed to pay the previously ordered water haulage surcharge of \$82.18, or any portion thereof.

It is our intention to preserve the status quo pending a determination on the merits of District's application for rehearing, which we shall address in a separate decision in the near future.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the customers of CMWSI who have not paid the previously ordered surcharge of \$82.18, or any portion

thereof, shall not have their service discontinued for failure to pay this surcharge amount, pending further order of the Commission.

This order is effective today.
