

ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This case has been held in abeyance at the request of complainants while they negotiated a settlement of their grievance with Citizens Utilities Company of California (CUCC). Because considerable time had elapsed since the filing of this complaint, the administrative law judge (ALJ) recently contacted Tim Johnson, one of the complainants, by telephone to determine if the complainants were still interested in prosecuting their complaint. He stated that their problem with CUCC had been resolved and that he would write to the ALJ requesting dismissal of the complaint. No letter has been received.

On April 28, 1988, the ALJ wrote to the complainants stating that their complaint would be dismissed for lack of prosecution unless they contacted him within two weeks of the date of the letter. No response has been received from the complainants.

Finding of Fact

The complainants have failed to prosecute their complaint.
