## ORDER MODIFYING DECISION 88-05-032

By Decision (D.) 88-05-032 dated May 11, 1988, we authorized Jim Carroll Cassil (Cassil), doing business as Cassil Trucking, to depart from the provisions of Rule 7.1 of General Order 147-A in connection with the transportation of tire products for Michelin Tire Company. On June 6, 1988 Cassil filed his Petition for Modification of D.88-05-032, asserting that the scale of rates attached to his original application, and authorized by the Commission in Appendix A to the decision, contained two typographical errors in the rate and minimum weight columns. The typographical errors are apparent as pointed out by Cassil and should be corrected.

## IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Appendix A of D.88-05-032 is modified by substituting a rate of "710" cents for the AQ 140 mile rate of 719 cents and by substituting a minimum weight heading of "24M" for the 40M heading shown.

2. In all other respects, D.88-05-032 shall remain in full force and effect.

This order is effective today.
