OPINION

Padre Transit Mix, Inc. (petitioner) has filed to request authority to modify Minimum Rate Tariff 17-A (MRT 17-A) and Delivery Zone Directory 1 to extend the application of zone rates from petitioner's production plant in Poway, California, to all established delivery zones in the County of San Diego.

Petitioner is a California corporation operating out of Poway, California. A copy of petitioner's Articles of Incorporation is attached to the original petition on file herein as required by Rule 16 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure.

Petitioner produces, markets, and distributes rock, sand, and gravel from a commercial plant located 1.4 miles by road, south and easterly of the intersection of Creek Road and Pomerado Road in the City of Poway, San Diego County. All loading is performed by front-end loaders. Independent carriers are hired to haul the rock, sand, and gravel to delivery zones in San Diego County. Petitioner cannot charge zone rates due to the Poway location not being classified as a production area. Petitioner is operating at a disadvantage since zone rates already apply from the plants of

its competitors for the transportation of rock, gravel, and sand from quarries or other pickup points.

The proposed production area is described in Appendix A to the application along with the results of a "test traverse" (Appendix B), which determines the traverse time and distance between the described production area and the intersection of Creek Road and Pomerado Road.

A copy of the petition was served on the California Asphalt Pavement Association, California Carriers Association, California Trucking Association, Nelson & Sloan, Southern California Rock Products Association, V. R. Dennis Construction Co., Associated Independent Owner Operators, Inc., California Dump Truck Owners Association, H. G. Fenton Material Co., Sim J. Harris Co., and South Coast Asphalt Products Co. The application was noticed in the Commission's Daily Calendar on March 23, 1988 and there have been no protests or requests for a hearing.

The Transportation Division has recommended that the application be granted.

Findings of Fact

- 1. Petitioner has filed to extend the application of zone rates to its production plant in Poway, California.
- 2. A grant of authority will enable petitioner to compete on an equal basis with other operators who already receive transportation at zone rates.
- 3. The rates adopted in the following order will result in just, reasonable, and nondiscriminatory minimum rates for the transportation involved.
 - 4. A public hearing is not necessary.

Conclusions of Law

1. The petition should be granted to the extent provided in the following order.

2. The effective date of this order should be today because there is an immediate need for the rate relief.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Minimum Rate Tariff (MRT) 17-A (Appendix C to Decision (D.) 80578, as amended) is further amended by incorporating Original Page 8-UU and Original Page 8-UU-1, attached, to become effective 30 days after today.
- 2. Southern California Production Area and Delivery Zone
 Directory 1 (Appendix A of D.65469, as amended) is further amended
 by incorporating Fourth Revised Page 252.3 and Fourth Revised
 Page 252.4, attached, to become effective 30 days after today.
- 3. In all other respects D.80578, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
 - 4. The petition is granted as set forth above.

5. The Executive Director shall serve a copy of this decision on each subscriber to MRT 17-A.

This order is effective today.
