## **OPINION**

Sonoma Airporter, Inc. (applicant), a California corporation, requests authority, pursuant to Sections (§) 1031 and 1032 of the Public Utilities (PU) Code, to provide additional on-call service in Oakmont, Kenwood, Eldridge, Glen Ellen, Arnold Drive and Madrone Road, Sears Point, Black Point, and door-to-door service for specified locations in Sonoma Valley. The application also asks elimination of the vehicle size limitation in its present certificate.

Applicant has been providing passenger stage service since January 1981 (PSC-1146, Decision (D.) 92565, Application (A.) 60003.) to and from the City of Sonoma and the surrounding unincorporated areas to San Francisco International Airport.

Notice of the filing of the application appeared in the Commission's Daily Transportation Calendar on August 19, 1988. In addition, notice of the filing of the application was served by applicant on all governmental agencies and regional transportation planning agencies within whose boundaries passengers will be loaded

and unloaded. There have been no protests to the application filed with the Commission and Transportation Division staff recommends exparte handling of the application.

## Findings of Fact

- 1. Applicant has the ability, equipment, and financial resources to perform the additional service.
  - 2. No protests to the application have been filed.
- 3. It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment.
  - 4. This order should be effective immediately.
  - 5. A public hearing is not necessary.

## Conclusion of Law

Public convenience and necessity have been demonstrated and a revised certificate should be granted to the applicant.

#### ORDER

#### IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Sonoma Airporter, Inc.'s certificate of public convenience and necessity (PSC-1146) is amended by adding Fifth Revised Page 1, Sixth Revised Page 2, and Original Page 3.
  - 2. Applicant shall:
    - a. File a written acceptance of this certificate within 30 days after this order is effective.
    - b. Establish the authorized service and file tariffs and timetables within 120 days after this order is effective.

- c. State in its tariffs and timetables when service will start; allow at least 10 days' notice to the Commission; and make timetables and tariffs effective 10 or more days after this order is effective.
- d. Comply with Commission General Orders and the California Highway Patrol safety rules.
- e. Maintain accounting records in conformity with the Uniform System of Accounts.
- f. Remit to the Commission the Transportation Reimbursement Fee required by PU Code § 403 when notified by mail to do so.
- 3. The application is granted as set forth above.

  This order is effective today.
