OPINION

Findings of Fact

1. Advanced Telesystems, Ltd. (ATS) filed Case (C.) 87-04-019 on April 13, 1987.
2. On May 22, 1987, Pacific Bell (Pacific) and Greg Castle filed an answer to the complaint and a motion for summary dismissal of Greg Castle as a defendant.
3. The assigned administrative law judge (ALJ) issued a ruling on June 8, 1988 instructing ATS to amend its complaint within 30 days to cite which provisions of law, tariff provisions, or any other order or rule of the Commission ATS believes Pacific violates as a basis of the complaint and to apprise the Commission of any changes in circumstances relevant to the case since it was filed.
4. ATS did not amend its complaint as instructed nor did it respond to the ALJ's ruling in any way.
5. In response to a subsequent attempt by the ALJ to reach ATS's counsel by telephone, ATS's counsel left a message that ATS does not intend to pursue this case.

Conclusion of Law

C.87-04-019 should be dismissed because the complainant has failed to prosecute the case.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that Case 87-04-019 is dismissed without prejudice.
