OPINION

Del Coronado Travel & Properties, Inc., a California corporation, requests authority under Public Utilities (PU) Code § 1031, et seq. to establish and operate a passenger stage corporation service for the transportation of passengers and baggage between Hotel del Coronado in San Diego County and San Diego International Airport.

Notice of filing of the application appeared in the Commission's Daily Transportation Calendar on August 17, 1988. In addition, notice of the filing of the application was served by applicant on all governmental agencies and regional transportation planning agencies within whose boundaries passengers will be loaded and unloaded. There have been no protests to the application filed with the Commission, and Transportation Division staff recommends ex parte handling of the application.

The application states that the proposed service is a replacement for and continuation of service already being provided by an authorized carrier which no longer wishes to transport hotel guests over the route requested.

Applicant states that it will acquire three 1988 Ford vans for passenger transport. A balance sheet attached to the application shows the corporation to have \$40,700 in assets and \$31,732 in stockholder's equity as of May 31, 1988.

Findings of Fact

1. Applicant has the ability, equipment, and financial resources to perform the proposed service.
2. No protests to the application have been filed.
3. It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment.
4. As no protests have been filed and there is a public need for the service, this order should be effective immediately.
5. A public hearing is not necessary.

Conclusion of Law

Public convenience and necessity have been demonstrated, and a certificate should be granted to applicant.

Only the amount paid to the state for operative rights may be used in rate fixing. The state may grant any number of rights and may cancel or modify the monopoly feature of these rights at any time.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. A certificate of public convenience and necessity is granted to Del Coronado Travel & Properties, Inc., authorizing it to operate as a passenger stage corporation, as defined in PU Code § 226, between the points and over the routes set forth in Appendix PSC-5113, to transport persons and their baggage.
2. Applicant shall:
  - a. File a written acceptance of this certificate within 30 days after this order is effective.
  - b. Establish the authorized service and file tariffs and timetables within 120 days after this order is effective.

- c. State in its tariffs and timetables when service will start; allow at least 10 days notice to the Commission; and make timetables and tariffs effective 10 or more days after this order is effective.
- d. Comply with General Orders Series 79, 98, 101, and 104, and the California Highway Patrol Safety Rules.
- e. Maintain accounting records in conformity with the Uniform System of Accounts.
- f. Remit to the Commission the transportation reimbursement fee required by PU Code § 403 when notified by mail to do so.

3. Prior to initiating service to any airport, applicant shall notify the airport authority involved. This certificate does not authorize the holder to conduct any operations on the property of or into any airport unless such operation is authorized by both this Commission and the airport authority involved.

4. Applicant is authorized to begin operations on the date that the executive director mails a notice to applicant that it has evidence of insurance on file with the Commission and that the California Highway Patrol has approved the use of applicant's vehicles for service.

5. The application is granted as set forth above.

This order is effective today.

SECTION 1. GENERAL AUTHORIZATIONS, RESTRICTIONS, LIMITATIONS,  
AND SPECIFICATIONS.

Del Coronado Travel & Properties, Inc., by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by the decision noted in the margin, is authorized to transport passengers and their baggage between Hotel del Coronado and San Diego International Airport (SAN) on an on-call basis, subject, however, to the authority of this Commission to change or modify the route at any time and subject to the following provisions:

- (a) When route descriptions are given in one direction, they apply to operations in either direction unless otherwise indicated.
- (b) The term "on-call" as used refers to service which is authorized to be rendered dependent on the demands of passengers. The tariffs and timetables shall show the conditions under which the authorized on-call service will be rendered.
- (c) Only passengers originating at or destined to SAN shall be transported.
- (d) This certificate does not authorize the holder to conduct any operation on the property of or into any airport unless such operation is authorized by both this Commission and the airport authority involved.
