ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR
 MODIFICATION OF RESOLUTION G-2779

A Petition for Modification of Resolution G-2779 has been filed by Southern California Utility Power Pool and Imperial Irrigation District. We have carefully considered the allegations contained in the petition and are of the opinion that the petition should be denied on the grounds of mootness. The challenge to Resolution G-2779 is directed to the elimination for Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) of a separate priority designation for enhanced oil recovery (EOR) customers. We have already reconsidered this issue in R.88-08-018 which has been consolidated with I.87-03-036. In Decision No. 88-12-099 issued in that proceeding on December 19, 1989, we directed the utilities to place EOR steamflood operations in Priority 5, along with electric powerplant use. Both PG&E and Southern California Gas Company were ordered to make appropriate advice letter filings to change their tariff rules accordingly. THEREFORE,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

The petition for modification of Resolution G-2779 is denied.

This order is effective today.
