

On November 30, 1988, it was ruled by the presiding Administrative Law Judge that complainants should file (1) a formal response to the motion to dismiss indicating whether this complaint is now moot, or (2) an amended complaint indicating what relief is being requested within 30 days.

No pleadings have been filed by complainant within the time prescribed. Therefore, defendant's motion to dismiss this complaint is granted.

IT IS ORDERED that this complaint is hereby dismissed with prejudice.

This order becomes effective 30 days from today.
