OPINION

On March 23, 1988, an investigation was instituted on the Commission's own motion into the parcel rates proposed by Lawlor Motor Express (Lawlor) in its Cost Justification 87-82OR.

On January 26, 1989, Lawlor informed the Commission by letter that it was its desire to cancel Cal. P.U.C. No. 3 Tariff (87-82OR) as Lawlor is no longer in the parcel business.

Finding of Fact

Lawlor has requested cancellation of its application to transport parcels and shipments of less than 1,000 pounds under rates to be published in Tariff No. 3 (CJ 87-82OR).

Conclusion of Law

Cal. P.U.C. No. 3 Tariff (87-82OR) should be canceled and this investigation discontinued.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:


