ORDER MODIFYING DECISION

Decision (D.) 88-12-014, dated December 9, 1988 (in Application 88-09-007), authorized applicant to deviate from the minimum rates in MRT 7-A on the transportation of silica sand from the U.S. Silica Company in Oceanside, to Brockway Glass Company, Inc., at Pomona, California. The rate authorized by the decision is \$6.70 per ton, with a minimum weight of 26 tons per unit of equipment. The tariff rate is \$8.40 per ton with a minimum weight of 24 tons per shipment.

Applicant filed a Petition to Modify Decision 88-12-014 on December 27, 1988, which requested that the rate be reduced from \$6.70 per ton, to \$6.48 per ton, and that the minimum weight per shipment be reduced to 24 tons. Apart from these two changes, D.88-12-014 was to remain in full force and effect.

The petition is supported by a letter from the shipper. Applicant alleges that other carriers are hauling for the lower rate and applicant must conform or lose the business.

Applicant has included a cost study which indicates that the total mileage will be 162, and the gross revenue \$168.48. Costs will amount to \$157.90, with an operating income of \$10.58. The transportation will be performed at an operating ratio of 94%.

Notice of the filing of the petition was provided in the Commission's Daily Calendar on January 3, 1989. There have been no protests or requests for a hearing. The Commission staff has recommended that the petition be granted without a hearing.

Pindings of Pact

- 1. Applicant has petitioned to modify D.88-12-014 to further reduce a deviated rate authorized by D.88-12-014.
- 2. The petition was filed for authority to charge a rate which is currently used by other carriers.
- 3. A cost study indicates that the rate applied for will be compensatory.
 - 4. The proposed rate is reasonable.
 - 5. A hearing is not necessary.

Conclusions of Law

- 1. The application should be granted.
- 2. This order should be made effective on the date signed because there is an immediate need for rate relief.
- 3. The authority granted by this order and D.88-12-014 shall expire one year after the effective date of this order.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. J. C. McClinton Trucking Company, Inc., a corporation, may depart from the rates in MRT 7-A by charging not less than \$6.48 per ton, on a minimum of 24 tons per load, while transporting silica sand from the U.S. Silica Company, Oceanside, to the Brockway Glass Company, at Pomona.
- 2. In all other respects, the provisions of D.88-12-014 shall remain in full force and effect.

3. The authority granted herein and by D.88-12-014 shall expire one year after the effective date of this order. This order APR 12 1889 today.
