ORDER MODIFYING ORDER INSTITUTING INVESTIGATION

On March 8, 1989, we issued Investigation (I.) 89-03-004, which will consider walkway conditions along railroad tracks, among other matters. Ordering Paragraph 2 named as respondents to the proceeding all railroad corporations under our jurisdiction. However, Oakland Terminal Railway was inadvertently left off the list of respondent companies. In order to promote the safe operation of all rail companies under our jurisdiction, we will modify our order to include Oakland Terminal Railway as a respondent.

IT IS ORDERED that Ordering Paragraph 2 of I.89-03-004 is amended to include Oakland Terminal Railway as a respondent.

This order is effective today.
