## ORDER DENYING REHEARING OF DECISION 88-11-028

GEORGE M. SAWAYA (Complainant), has filed an application for rehearing of Decision (D.) 88-11-028, asking that we: (1) respond to his request regarding notification to subscribers of Touch-Tone Calling Service in step-by-step territories that the service to which they are subscribing does not place telephone calls faster than standard rotary dial service; (2) delete Conclusion of Law Nos. 1 and 2; (3) exclude from the Decision, references to reasonableness of the rate for Touch-Tone Calling Service; (4) furnish complainant with a copy of I.87-11-083; (5) furnish complainant with a copy of the findings of ALJ Gilman.

We have thoroughly considered the allegations and other arguments in the application and are of the opinion that good cause does not exist for granting rehearing in this matter as complainant has failed to comply with the procedural requirements of Public Utilities Code section 1702. The Commission has previously provided complainant with a copy of I.87-11-083 and notified him that no published proposed order was filed by the ALJ in this matter. Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the application for rehearing of D.88-11-028 filed by George M. Sawaya is denied.
