ORDER CORRECTING INADVERTENT OMISSION

The Commission has discovered an inadvertent omission in an ordering paragraph of Decision 89-05-063. Although specified in the discussion portion of the opinion, the specific authorization was inadvertently omitted in the ordering paragraph.


Under Resolution A-4661,

IT IS ORDERED that the underlined words in the following are added so that the omission in Ordering Paragraph 1.b. is restored and the corrected paragraph reads as follows:

- 1.b. The costs incurred by a public utility in unrecompensed administration and collection, including credit actions, incidental in the foregoing subparagraphs (a) and (b), and with regard to such administration and collection costs caused by the imposition of utility users taxes, subject to approval in an advice letter. Utilities shall not seek recovery of the same administrative costs in a general rate case; such double counting is strictly prohibited.

This order is effective today.
