ORDER CORRECTING CLERICAL ERROR

Decision 89-06-004 dated June 7, 1989 authorized applicant to adopt and publish a changed tariff rule regarding documentation on split pickups and split deliveries. The need to publish the new rule was stated in both findings and conclusions of law, but was inadvertently omitted from Ordering Paragraph 1 of the decision, which reads:

"Joe Costa Trucking is authorized to depart from tariff regulations and the provisions of General Order 147-A to the extent set forth in Appendix A attached."

Pursuant to Resolution A-4661,


IT IS ORDERED that Ordering Paragraph 1 is amended as

follows:

1. Joe Costa Trucking is authorized to depart from tariff regulations and the provisions of General Order 147-A to the extent necessary and to publish in his tariff the provisions set forth in Appendix A attached.
